

## Kildare County Council Libraries

### Public Access Computers with Internet Access - Terms and Conditions of Use

Kildare County Council provides public access computers with access to the Internet as a service to library members subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. Access to this service is for Library members via Library Card Number and PIN.
2. The Library card is non-transferable and may be used **only by the person** to whom it was issued. Non authorised use will result in revoking access to the Public Access computers.
3. Sessions may be of 50 or 20 minutes duration and may be booked in advance
4. Sessions may be restricted to one session per person per day
5. There is no charge for this service but all printing is subject to a charge at different rates for A4, A3, black & white or colour printing. Please check with staff for current rates.
6. Public access computers with Internet access are provided on a self-learning basis and library staff may not always be available to assist users
7. Users are subject to ALL legislation with regard to the use of electronic communication and each user is responsible for use of this electronic resource in an ethical and lawful manner.
8. Use of service by children is the responsibility of their parent/guardian. Kildare County Council bears no responsibility for the deliberate or unintentional exposure of children to disturbing or inappropriate content or images. All children are required to have parental/guardian consent to use this service.
9. Not all information found on the Internet is accurate, complete, up to date or otherwise acceptable to all individuals. Kildare County Council is not responsible for the accuracy, quality or content of the information retrieved from the Internet. Any infringements of copyright are the responsibility of the user.
10. Kildare County Council cannot accept responsibility for any damage, loss, costs or expenses arising from usage of this service. By accepting this policy, a user of this service agrees to indemnify Kildare County Council in respect of any damage, loss, costs or expenses whatsoever either to the user or any third party that arise from this service, which indemnity includes any legal proceedings whatsoever (including any and all costs thereof) that arise from the user of this service.

14. Users are reminded that from time to time that the service may be unavailable for technical, maintenance, or other reasons beyond the control of Library staff. Kildare County Council reserves the right to withdraw this service from individual library members, or the service in general, without notice at any time in the future.
