Following on from the recent workshop I would like to add a few other idea's to the consultation process

1. Investment should be made in the town to make it wheel chair friendly and accessible. This includes access to schools, Town Hall, Churches, Shops and repair and enhancement to all pedestrian pathways etc.
2. Safe walk ways should be provided around the town, more zebra crossings on the ring road are essential, particularly close to schools etc.
3. Truck Cab / bus carpark should be available within walking distance of key estates rather than have these large trucks cluttering up parking spots outside Ballycane Church.
4. investment should be made to create an interactive childrens science museum (based on the one in Belfast). This will encourage tourism, constant flow of people in to the town and increased economic spend in the town. Perhaps converting one of the derelict sites / shops on the main street. Alternatively an interactive history museum using the St Davids Site - sponsorship could be sought from the new Town Centre Shopping Mall
5. Increase the number of playgrounds in the Town. There are none around the Caragh side of town. These should automatically be incorporated in to new residential building.
6. Increase the capabilities in Ballycane school from 2nd class to 6th Class - our increasing population will need more schools.
7. Perhaps expand the library or community centre in to a cultural and arts centre.
8. The Town should adopt a proage policy similar to that adopted by Louth Co Co.
9. All street lighting etc should be solar powered.
10. Recycling should have a more predominant role in the town. More recycle bins / collection points / promotions etc.

I think it would be hugely beneficial for the planning team to consult with our school going population for further idea's.

My concern as I finish this email is that a lack of budget will stop any advancements or improvements.
