2009

Naas Town Council (hereinafter referred to as the Council) in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 101 of the Road Traffic Act, 1961 (No. 24 of 1961) as amended by Section 6 of the Road Traffic Act, 1968 (No. 25 of 1968) as amended by Section 36 of the Road Traffic Act, 1994 (No. 7 of 1994) **hereby make the following Bye-Laws:-**

PART 1

PRELIMINARY

Short Title	1	These Byelaws may be cited as “Naas Town Council Parking Bye-Laws, 2009”.
Commencement	2	These Bye-Laws shall come into operation on the date passed by the Members of Naas Town Council
	3	These byelaws apply to the area comprising the administrative area of Naas Town Council and as shown on accompanying map reference no. NTC 09 06 93R1
Interpretation/Definitions	4	<p>“<i>the regulations of 1997</i>” means the Road Traffic (Traffic and Parking) Regulations 1997 (SI No. 182 of 1997).</p> <p>“<i>the signs regulations of 1997</i>” means the Road Traffic (Sign) Regulations 1997 (SI No. 181 of 1997).</p> <p>“<i>pay parking place</i>” means a place on a public road or car park in Naas where the parking of vehicles is subject to exhibition of a prepaid parking ticket.</p> <p>“<i>buffer area</i>” means an area between two parking bays, and is normally delineated by linear hatching on the road.</p> <p>“<i>parking bay</i>” means a space in a parking place for the parking of one mechanically propelled vehicle and so indicated by surface markings and where parking signs RRM011, RRM012, RRM013, or RRM014 are provided.</p> <p>“<i>appropriate pay & display parking ticket machine</i>” means a pay and display parking ticket machine located on the public road on which the vehicle is parked or on an adjacent public road, where indicated on an information sign.</p> <p>“<i>Community Warden</i>” has the meaning assigned to it by Section (2) of The Local Authorities Traffic Wardens Act, 1975 (No. 14 of 1975), as amended, and additional functions in the areas of community liaison, and litter and dog control.</p> <p>“<i>Agent for the council</i>” means any person employed by the Council, or any person authorised</p>

		<p>by the Council to carryout functions under these Bye-Laws.</p> <p>“authorised person” means an employee of the Council, who is actively engaged in work for the Council at the time of parking the vehicle.</p> <p>“goods vehicle” means a vehicle used exclusively for the carriage of goods or burden in the course of trade or business and taxed as a goods vehicle.</p> <p>“loading bay” means that portion of a road indicated by means of a traffic sign RRM009 accompanied by an information plate on which at certain times a vehicle other than a goods vehicle being used for loading or unloading shall <u>not</u> be parked.</p> <p>“car park” means an area comprising pay parking places designated especially for parking in which the Council has a legal, proprietary, or equitable interest.</p> <p>“immediate family member” means a spouse, father, mother, brother, sister, son, daughter, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, niece, nephew, aunt, or uncle.</p> <p>“information plate” means a plate accompanying a traffic sign which indicates the period during which the restrictions or prohibition indicated by such traffic sign applies”.</p> <p>“business hours” means with respect to Monday to Saturday (which is not a holiday) the period commencing not earlier than 8.30 a.m. and terminating not later than 6.30 p.m. or as may be determined by the Council from time to time.</p> <p>“appropriate fee” means the fee, prescribed in these bye-laws, for the parking area in which the vehicle is parked</p> <p>“parking fee” means a fee payable (as set out in Appendix 1) in accordance with these bye-laws for the parking of a vehicle.</p> <p>“pay and display parking ticket” means a parking ticket which is issued by Naas Town Council by means of a pay and display parking ticket machine and which contains the following particulars:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. the fee paid in respect of the ticket b. the date and time of issue of the ticket c. the time of expiry of the ticket d. the area to which the ticket is applicable. e. The zone to which the ticket is applicable. <p>“pay and display parking ticket machine” means a machine capable of automatically delivering a pay</p>
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		<p>and display parking ticket when the appropriate parking fee prescribed by these bye-laws is paid.</p> <p>“large public service vehicle” means a public service vehicle having a seating passenger accommodation for more than 8 persons exclusive of the driver.</p> <p>“public service vehicle” means a mechanically propelled vehicle used for the carriage of persons for reward.</p> <p>“ticket parking area” means an area on a public road where traffic sign No. RUS018 authorised by the Signs Regulations of 1997 together with an accompanying information sign indicates that parking of vehicles is subject to the exhibition of a pay and display parking ticket.</p> <p>“ticket parking place” means a place on a public road where the parking of vehicles is subject to the exhibition of a valid pay and display parking ticket.</p> <p>“valid coins” means, the coins indicated on the appropriate pay and display parking ticket machine.</p> <p>“valid pay and display parking ticket” means a pay and display parking ticket which was purchased at an appropriate pay and display parking ticket machine and has not expired.</p> <p>“holiday” means Good Friday or any day that is a Public Holiday for the purpose of the Holiday (Employees) Act, 1973 (No. 25 of 1973) as amended.</p> <p>“disabled persons parking permit” means a permit granted in accordance with Article 43 of the Regulations of 1997.</p> <p>“residential parking permit area” means a ticket parking area where traffic sign no. RUS018 authorised by the Signs Regulations of 1997 together with an accompanying information sign indicates that parking of vehicles is subject to the exhibition of a pay and display parking ticket and that it is a residential parking permit area.</p> <p>“residential parking permit place” means a ticket parking place in a residential parking permit area.</p> <p>“disabled parking bay” means a parking bay as set out under schedules 12 and 13 of this Bye Law, and which shall be reserved exclusively for the use of a car which holds a <i>disabled parking permit</i> and which is being used for the carriage of a person of reduced mobility.</p>
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PART II

PAY AND DISPLAY TICKET PARKING

<p>Parking in pay and display ticket parking places.</p>	<p>5 (1)</p>	<p>The following provisions shall apply during operational hours to the parking of a vehicle in a ticket parking place –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) subject to paragraph (2) of this bye-law, a vehicle which is parked in a ticket parking place during operational hours shall, where parking bays are provided at that ticket parking place, be parked within the area comprising a parking bay, (b) a vehicle which had been parked in a ticket parking place for the maximum period permitted in that ticket parking place, as indicated on the appropriate pay and display ticket parking machine in accordance with Bye-Law 10, shall not be parked again in a ticket parking place on the public road in which that ticket parking place is situated until at least one-hour has elapsed since the vehicle was last parked in that ticket parking place, (c) a vehicle shall not be parked in a buffer area, (d) a vehicle parked in a ticket parking place at a time which is not during operational hours shall be removed from the ticket parking place when a period of operational hours commences, unless at such commencement and during the remainder of the period of parking, a valid pay and display parking ticket is exhibited in the interior of the vehicle in accordance with bye-law 7(2) of these bye-laws and bye-law 7(3) of these bye-laws shall apply from such commencement in respect of such parking,
	<p>(2)</p>	<p>Notwithstanding paragraph (1) (a) of this bye-law, a vehicle parked in a parking bay during operational hours may project into an adjoining buffer area if the length of the vehicle prevents its being parked wholly in accordance with paragraph (1)(a) of this bye-law.</p>
	<p>(3)</p>	<p>This bye-law shall not apply to a parking bay when the pay display parking ticket machine for that parking bay is temporarily suspended from operation in accordance with bye-law 12.</p>
<p>Vehicles which may be parked in pay and display ticket parking place.</p>	<p>6</p>	<p>Mechanically propelled vehicles only, of the following classes, may be parked in a ticket parking place during operational hours</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) a passenger vehicle with passenger accommodation for not more than twelve persons excluding the driver and not drawing a trailer or other vehicle (b) a goods vehicle whose unladen weight does not exceed two tones, which is not actively loading in or on to it or unloading from it and not drawing a trailer or other vehicle.
<p>Obligation to display a valid parking ticket.</p>	<p>7 (1)</p>	<p>A valid pay and display parking ticket shall be displayed as specified in this bye-law on the interior of a vehicle lawfully parked in a pay and display ticket parking place in a ticket parking area during operational hours.</p>
	<p>(2)</p>	<p>The valid pay and display parking ticket shall be so exhibited in the interior of the vehicle that a person outside the vehicle can ascertain when the parking ticket ceases to be valid.</p>

	(3)	The pay and display parking ticket shall be exhibited in accordance with paragraph (2) of this bye-law for so long as the vehicle is parked in that ticket parking place.
Fees	8	The parking fee payable during operational hours in respect of the vehicles specified in paragraph (a) and (b) of bye-law 6 in the areas as defined by resolution of Naas Town Council shall be in accordance with Appendix I of the Byelaws.
Manner and time of payment of parking fee.	9 (1)	A pay and display parking ticket shall be purchased from an appropriate pay and display parking ticket machine.
	(2)	The fee for the pay and display parking ticket shall be payable by means of any combination of valid coins. The method of payment will be indicated on the pay and display parking ticket machine.
	(3)	Payment by cash shall be made by inserting the appropriate fee for the parking time required in to the appropriate parking ticket machine and following the instructions on the parking ticket machine in order to obtain a valid pay and display parking ticket.
	(4)	Payment can be made the evening or night beforehand for the maximum period applicable following the commencement of operations the following morning.
	(5)	The valid parking ticket shall be displayed immediately upon parking provided that, where a vehicle is parked at a time not during operational hours, the valid parking ticket shall be displayed in accordance with bye-law 7 at the commencement of operational hours.
Period of parking in ticket parking place.	10	A vehicle parked in a ticket parking place during operational hours shall not be so parked for a period longer than the maximum period for which parking is permitted on that day in that ticket parking place as indicated on the appropriate pay and display parking ticket machine located on the public road in which the vehicle is parked or on an adjacent public road, where indicated on an information sign.
Motor cycles and pedal cycles prohibited from parking in pay and display ticket parking places.	11. (1)	A motor cycle or pedal cycle shall not be parked during operational hours in a ticket parking place, except in that place designated under Schedule 14.
	(2)	When a motor cycle is parked in a designated parking space as set out under Schedule 14; it shall incur the parking charge relevant to that parking zone.
Suspension of pay & display machines or ticket parking places.	12.	<p>(a) Naas Town Council may suspend from operation a pay and display parking ticket machine or a ticket parking place in a ticket parking area. The suspension shall be subject to conditions which may be specified in writing by Naas Town Council, including the payment of fee/fees by the person requesting the suspension.</p> <p>(b) The maximum fee/fees payable shall be as indicated in Appendix II.</p> <p>(c) The suspension of a pay and display parking ticket machine or a ticket parking place shall be indicated by the placing thereon of a sign or other device clearly indicating that it is non-operational or by the temporary removal of the pay and display parking ticket machine and the erection of a sign indicating that the parking of vehicles is prohibited in the ticket parking place.</p> <p>(d) It shall be an offence to breach a condition specified in writing by Naas Town Council when a pay and display parking ticket machine or a ticket parking place is being suspended. In the event of vehicles being parked in contravention of these conditions they shall be deemed to be unlawfully parked for the purposes of the Road Traffic Acts and any regulations made thereunder.</p>

Interference.	13	<p>(a) No person shall insert any coin, article, or object, other than the coins specified for the purchase of a pay and display parking ticket, in a pay and display parking ticket machine, or interfere in any other way with a pay and display parking ticket machine in a ticket parking place.</p> <p>(b) No person other than an agent of Naas Town Council, a member of the Garda Síochána, an authorised person, or a Community warden shall interfere in any way with a hood, sign or other device placed on a pay and display parking ticket machine in a ticket parking place.</p> <p>(c) A person shall not interfere with, alter or deface a pay and display parking ticket or machine.</p>
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PART III

PARKING PERMIT FOR RESIDENTS

Definitions for Part III	14	<p>In this part of the bye-laws – “acceptable evidence” means the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(i) a current insurance certificate confirming that the vehicle is normally kept by the resident at the residents address in the residents parking permit zone to which the permit will relate and(ii) (a) a vehicle licensing certificate or a registration book confirming that the resident applying for a resident’s parking permit is the registered owner of the vehicle in respect of which the application for a residents parking permit is being made and that the vehicle is registered at the residents address in the residents parking permit zone to which the permit will relate or (b) where the applicant is not the registered owner of the vehicle in respect of which the application for a residents parking permit is being made, the vehicle licensing certificate or a registration book for the vehicle with satisfactory documentary evidence from the registered owner that the vehicle is normally kept by the applicant at the residents address in the residents parking permit zone to which the permit will relate and evidence from the Revenue Commissioners that a vehicle owned by the registered owner is normally kept by the applicant and(iii) a driving or provisional licence in the name of the resident applying for the residents parking permit and(iv) utility bills, bank statements, or other documentation, acceptable to Naas Town Council, addressed to the applicant at his/her address in the residents parking zone to which the residents parking permit will relate and(v) Where the applicant is resident in a rented house, confirmation that the dwelling is registered with Naas Town Council in accordance with the provisions of the Housing (Registration of Rented Houses) Regulations 1996 and(vi) The property in question is not rateable and(vii) The property in question has been developed or converted in accordance with proper planning and sustainability as defined in the Planning and Development Act 2000 and subsequent amendments and(viii) Any other information which maybe requested by Naas Town Council <p>“owner” means that person specifically named in the vehicle licensing certificate;</p> <p>“rented house” means a dwelling required to be registered in accordance with the Housing (Registration of Rented Houses) Regulations 1996.</p>
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		<p>“resident” means a person, other than the occupant of a purpose built apartment block, who satisfies Naas Town Council that his/her normal dwelling place is at premises situated in a street in a residential parking permit area;</p> <p>“residential property” means that the property referred to is the full-time and principal home of the person. Persons who own commercial property on a street but whose principle residence lies elsewhere will not qualify for such a permit.</p> <p>“residents parking permit” means a document issued by Naas Town Council or its agents for the purposes of bye-laws 15-21 and containing the particulars specified in bye-law 16.</p> <p>“valid resident’s parking permit” means a residents parking permit issued in respect of the vehicle on which the residents parking permit is displayed which relates to the residential parking permit zone in which the vehicle is parked and to a period which has not expired and which is issued by the Councils or its agents.</p>
Non-application bye-laws 5-13 of these bye-laws.	15	Bye-laws 5-13 of these bye-laws shall not apply to the parking of a vehicle in a residential parking permit place if there is displayed in accordance with bye-law 18 of these bye-laws on the vehicle when it is so parked, a valid residents parking permit.
Particulars of residents parking permit.	16	A residents parking permit shall contain the following particulars: (a) the words Comhairle Baile Ceanntair Nas Na Riogh (b) the registration number of the vehicle in respect of which it is issued, (c) the residential parking permit zone to which it relates, (d) the date of expiry of the residents parking permit. (e) The unique serial number attributable to each permit.
Permission to park vehicle displaying residents parking permit.	17	The display, in accordance with bye-law 18 of a valid resident’s parking permit on the vehicle in respect of which the permit was issued, shall permit the vehicle to be parked without limitation as to time in a parking place in the residential parking permit zone to which the permit relates.
Display of residents parking permit.	18	A valid resident’s parking permit shall be so displayed in the interior of the vehicle in respect of which it is issued that it can be read from outside the vehicle.
Interference with residents parking permit.	19	Where a vehicle displaying a resident’s parking permit is parked in a parking place a person shall not interfere with the residents parking permit.
Issue of and fee for residents parking permits.	20	(1) A resident’s parking permit may be issued by Naas Town Council in respect of the parking of a vehicle in a residential parking permit place.
		(2) A resident’s parking permit may be issued by Naas Town Council subject to the provisions of subsection 3 of this bye-law in respect of one vehicle of which the resident is the owner where Naas Town Council is satisfied, following production of acceptable evidence, that the applicant is resident in a street in the residential parking permit zone to which the permit will relate and that the vehicle is normally

		kept at the residents normal dwelling place in that street. The residents parking permit shall be granted for a period of either one year or a period of two years from the date of issue, in respect of that vehicle and for the residential parking permit zone to which the permit relates.
	(3)	(i) where the premises are a single housing unit, the maximum number of residents in that premises who may concurrently hold a residents parking permit shall be 1. (ii) Where the premises consist of more than 1 residential unit the maximum number of residents in each unit who may concurrently hold a residents parking permit shall be 1.
	(4)	The fee for a residents parking permit shall be that as set out in Appendix I.
Issue of replacement residents parking permits.	21	Where Naas Town Council are satisfied that a valid residents parking permit has been lost, destroyed or stolen the Council shall issue a replacement to the owner on payment of a fee as set out in Appendix I and such replacement permit shall be substituted for the original permit. The original permit shall thereafter be declared invalid.
Return of resident's parking permit.	22	Where, during the period to which a resident's parking permit relates, the holder ceases to reside at the address notified at the time of issue of the permit or ceases to be an owner by disposing of the vehicle to which the permit relates, he/she shall return the resident's parking permit to the Council. No refund will be applicable.
Transfer of Parking permit.	23	If the holder of a resident's parking permit for a vehicle replaces that vehicle with another the Council may, following the surrender of the original permit, issue a resident's parking permit in respect of the new vehicle which shall be valid for the remainder of the period specified on the original permit. A fee as per Appendix I will apply in such circumstances.
Display of a void resident's parking permit.	25	It shall be an offence to display a void residents parking permit.
Cancellation of residents permit	26	If at any stage, Naas Town Council finds that the holder of a permit has willfully or purposefully engaged in a practice to deceive the Council via the Residents Parking Permit Scheme, all parking permits attributable to that property will be withdrawn from that property for a minimum period of one year.
Issue of resident's parking permit to non-resident family member(s)	27	A resident's parking permit may be issued by the Council with a maximum of two vehicle registration numbers on the permit for up to two non-resident immediate family members who act as voluntary carers for a resident whose normal dwelling place is in a residential parking permit zone and who requires on-going daily care. The resident's parking permit shall be issued annually subject to the submission of the immediate family member(s) insurance certificate(s) and written confirmation from the resident's doctor that the resident requires on-going daily care.

PART IV

MISCELLANEOUS

Non-application of bye-laws 5-	28	Bye-laws 5-13 of these bye-laws shall not apply to – (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the removal of an obstruction to traffic, the removal of a vehicle pursuant to section 97 of the 1961 Road Traffic Act as amended, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a public road, the provision, alteration or repair of a main drain, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, oil, water or electricity or of a telephone line or the provision of a traffic sign, (b) A fire brigade vehicle, an ambulance or a state registered vehicle being used by a member of the Garda Siochana or the Defence Forces in the performance of his/her duties as such member. (c) A vehicle registered to Naas Town Council. (d) A vehicle being used by a community warden or other officer of the Council while that officer is in the performance of their duty for the Council during business hours. (e) A vehicle parked in which a valid disabled persons' permit is displayed and which is parked for the convenience of the person to whom that permit was granted, so long as the permit is prominently displayed on the vehicle when that vehicle is parked in a pay and display ticket parking place. (f) A vehicle parked at the edge of the public road while a passenger is entering or leaving it, (g) A vehicle in the interior of which is displayed a valid Residents Parking Permit issued by Naas Town Council.
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Offences	29	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. offences under these bye laws shall be enforced through Section 3(3) of the Local Authorities (Traffic Wardens) Acts 1975 and 1987, and the Council or its Agents may additionally utilize the powers conferred on them under the Road Traffic (Immobilization of Vehicles) Regulations, 1998. 2. in relation to offences other than those specified in Paragraph 1 of this bye law, the Council may, pursuant to Section 41 of the Local Government act 2001, serve a fixed payment notice on any person committing an offence by virtue of a contravention of these bye laws. Such fixed payment notice shall specify the amount of the fixed payment and the period within which the fixed payment must be paid in order to avoid prosecution and shall be in the general for of the notice set out in the first schedule to the Local Government Act 1994 (Bye Laws) Regulations, 1995-SI No. 360 of 1995 – (or as provided for in any amending regulations) but subject to such alterations thereto as the Council may consider appropriate in the case of these bye laws. 3. The amount of the fixed payment applicable to the fixed payment notice shall be as follows: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) €40 for parking in a designated space without the appropriate parking ticket, b) €80 for parking in a designated disabled parking space without a disabled persons parking permit displayed. c) €60 if the fixed penalty as set under bye law 4(a) is not paid within 28 days. d) €120 if the fixed penalty as set out under bye law 4(b) is not paid within 28 days. 4. Any person in breach of these bye laws shall be guilty of an offence and may be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding €1,000 or, at the discretion of the Court, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months, or to both such fine and imprisonment.
Disclaimer	30	<p>In accordance with Section 36(13) of the Road Traffic Act, 1994; the performance of the Council in the functions under these bye laws shall not render the Council subject to any liability in respect of loss or damage to any vehicle in a parking space or the contents of such vehicle.</p>
