Kildare failed to take advantage of Coill Dubh's defeat twenty-four hours earlier and take over second spot in the Senior Division when they came out on the wrong side of a 4-2 result at Canal Road. Kildare Started off brightly and after seven minutes they created the first real opportunity when Andrew Sage crossed in from wide on the right for Jason O'-Neill to head over from close range. Two minutes later O'Neill again got on the end of a Raymond Kelly Kick out only to see his flick on go out wide. In the twelfth minute Kildare keeper Jason O'Neill brought a superb save from Rathangan keeper Mark Doyle when a long kick out by Town keeper Raymond Kelly was met on the volley but the keeper managed to tip the ball over for a corner and as Kildare continued to dominate Joe Darcy flicked wide in the twenty-first minute after great work from Robert O'Neill.

Whatever was in the half time refreshments in the home dressing room worked wonder as Rathangan came out a different side, showing far more urgency. The efforts soon paid off as in the fifty-fifth minute with a superb goal by Tommy Power who took advantage of great work down the right by Sam O'Loughlin and Eoin Kennedy.

This seemed to be the break Rathangan needed and they pushed on looking for a second. Their efforts were soon awarded when Tommy Maloney was fouled by Johnny Phelan just outside the box. Pauric Kelly stepped up and drilled his free into top right corner leaving Kildare keeper Ray Kelly rooted to the spot. The home side now rang the changes introducing Richard Kelly for Tommy Maloney and Ned Cullen making way for Mark McCormack. The game was over as a contest in the 57 Minute when Sam O Loughlin took on Ian Murphy who took down the midfielder leaving referee John Dwayne with no option but to point to the spot. Sub McCormack took responsibility for the spot kick and sent Kelly in the Town goals the wrong way, virtually assuring Rathangan of all three points.

Kildare Brought Alan Ray on for Ian Carter and he made an immediate impact creating chances for Andrew Sage and Joe Darcy but both were denied by fine saves from home keeper Mark Doyle. The visitors pulled a goal back in the eightieth minute when Robert O'Neill netted a free from the edge of the box after Brian McGannon was fouled.

Rathangan however had no intention of letting this one slip they regained their three-goal advantage in the eighty-fifth minute when Sam O'Loughlin burst upfield, skipped past his marker Ian Murphy and unleashed a shot from the edge of the box which was too hot for keeper ray Kelly to handle.

Kildare, to their credit never gave up and they reduced the deficit to two goals with the last play of the game when a Brian McGannon throw was headed in by Alan Ray who timed his run perfectly.

Galhoy rejoined Newtown at the top of the table with a hard fought victory over bottom of the table Donard. The first half made it seem like it would be a formality with the home side dictating play and causing problems all over the park, especially down the right through Steve Dempsey and Darren Conway. The opening goal came twenty minutes in with Paul Dowling heading home from close range after Dave O'Connor's deep free kick was helped back across the box.

The second followed soon after when Paul Dyland's lovely ball allowed O'Connor to swivel and finish from inside the box. Galhoy had a number of chances to extend their lead and the away side would have been glad to hear the half time whistle come.

Donard came out with a different mentality in the second half and got a foothold in the game, whilst the home side were not at the races. Galhoy still pushed forward on the odd occasion but they lacked the finish that would have killed off the game. Stephen Archbold had perhaps the best chance to make it 3-0 but his effort was deflected wide. Donard set up a tense finish when they pulled a goal back with five minutes left – a fine individual effort from Harry Mangan- and although they looked for the equaliser Galhoy held them off comfortably.

Galhoy, who were best served by Dave O'Connor and Mark Tiernan in midfield, will not be entirely happy with this display and know they will have tougher tests ahead, while Donard can take heart from a much improved performance and if they can curtail their habit of giving away soft early goals the rest of the season should prove more fruitful for the County Wicklow side.
